

Tun Ismail Ali Challenge Terms and Conditions

- 1 The Tun Ismail Ali Challenge is open to undergraduates pursuing a Bachelor's Degree in economics or related degrees from both foreign and local universities. Applicants must have already completed at least two years of undergraduate studies.
- 2 The application opens on 3 May 2019 and closes at 5pm Malaysian time on 27 June 2019. Any submissions beyond the stipulated deadline will not be eligible for entry into the challenge.
- 3 If the entries are not of sufficient quality, the organiser may extend the closing date.
- 4 There will be a total of 3 cash prizes awarded:
 - *Champion*: RM 10000
 - *1st Runner-up*: RM 5000
 - *2nd Runner-up*: RM 3000The organisers reserve the right to change or vary the prizes mentioned above.
- 5 By submitting your entry application, you agree that all the information submitted in the application true and accurate. The organisers are entitled to reject your application without assigning any reason.
- 6 Your entry must be entirely your own work and nothing in your entry should be defamatory, obscene or an infringement of a copyright or intellectual property or the rights of a third party. Plagiarism is strictly prohibited and will lead to disqualification of the participant/team.
- 7 By submitting your entry for the challenge, you grant the organiser a non-exclusive license to use, republish, edit or modify your proposals in any media for purposes connected to the challenge.

- 8 Only one entry per person is allowed. You are not allowed to submit an application for more than one group and/or for both group and individual applications.
- 9 Previous participants who have reached the Final round (Top 3) of the Tun Ismail Ali Challenge are eligible to participate. However, they are not allowed to be in the same prior team or form a new team among each other.
- 10 The organisers reserve the right to cancel or postpone the challenge at any given time and shall not be liable for any losses or damages due to the cancellation or postponement.
- 11 The decision of the judges is final and cannot be challenged in any manner. No enquiry will be entertained.
- 12 By submitting the application form, you agree to have read, understood, and are bound by these term and conditions. The organiser reserves the right to alter these terms and conditions, including the right to disqualify participants who fail to abide by the stipulated terms and conditions
- 13 These terms and conditions and any disputes or claims arising out of these terms and conditions will be governed in accordance with the Malaysian law, whose courts shall have exclusive jurisdiction.
